Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to you to share with you the outstanding results across the school from the summer. As some of you will know, our results last year showed the school was above the national average in England and Wales for some subjects, and higher than many schools' results across Birmingham for both Key Stage One and Two. In the Early Years, the results were slightly below the national and Birmingham averages.

We are very pleased to share the results of summer 2015 with you. Across the board the children have performed amazingly well and we are incredibly proud of both their efforts and their progress. We have exceeded all of last year's national averages for every subject and have also significantly improved the progress of children who are in receipt of free school meals which is a major indicator for the government following the additional funding we have received as Pupil Premium money.

The table overleaf shows our results in comparison with all schools in England, Wales and Birmingham. As you will see this is a fine indication of how hard the children and staff have worked. We would also like to thank all of our parents and carers for your support in all school activities, workshops and with homework.

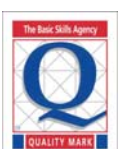
