MARRIAGE MATTERS www.twoinoneflesh.org.uk **Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time**
(Jeremiah 31: 7-9 Hebrews 5: 1-6 Mark 10: 46-52) *Ask and you will receive*
The prophet tells us today that if we ask, the Lord will always comfort, lead and guide us, so that we will not stumble. Jesus' response to Bartimaeus – "*What do you want me to do for you?*" – points the way. In marriage we become mirrors of God's saving help, supporting each other and being sure guides for our children.

All Saints (Apoc 7: 2-4, 9-14 1John 3: 1-3 Mtt 5: 1-12) *Rejoice, our reward is great in heaven*
As the opening prayer of Mass reminds us '...today we rejoice in the holy men and women of every time and place'.
