We are writing to you to share with you the outstanding results across the school from the summer. As some of you will know, our results in 2015 showed the school was above the national average in England and Wales for some subjects, and higher than many schools' results across Birmingham for both Key Stage One and Two. In the Early Years, the results were the same as the national and above the Birmingham averages.

We are very pleased to share the results of summer 2016 with you. Across the board the children have performed amazingly well and we are incredibly proud of both their efforts and their progress. This is especially true due to the higher demands on the children this year. As you will see once again the children in the Early Years have achieved well. The children who are in receipt of free school meals have achieved well and this is a major indicator for the government following the additional funding we have received as Pupil Premium money.

The table overleaf shows our results in comparison with all schools in England, Wales and Birmingham. As you will see this is a fine indication of how hard the children and staff have worked.
