



## Pupil Premium Spend 2014-2015 - £179, 400

- Smaller teaching groups in year groups R, Y1, Y2, Y4, Y5, Y6 across the year
- 1:1 Teaching support Y1 – Y6
- Small group support each afternoon for EAL/FSM children in Key stage 1 and 2.
- Booster teachers in KS1 and KS2
- Additional teachers to boost in Y6 and Y2 from Jan 2015
- Appointment of Language Learning Mentor to work with targeted children
- Reading intervention programme in Y6 for three afternoons to improve comprehension, inference and deduction skills with targeted children.
- Comprehension intervention in Y6 from Jan 2015
- CODEX reading intervention (12 week targeted) in Y3 and Y4.
- Two catch-up Maths interventions (12 weeks) in KS2
- Learning Mentor support programmes (social groups/Rainbows bereavement, loss and separation friendship and social skills).
- Curriculum projects (Y1 reading book project/Science super learning)
- Investing in family support with the Learning Mentor and Language Learning Mentor working with targeted families.
- Working in partnership with a range of agencies to provide social, emotional and communication support to families (speech therapy, holiday provision, mentoring and curriculum projects, music self-esteem)
- Extra-curricular activities and experiences (before/after school and lunchtime sports clubs)
- Aspiration activities for targeted children (Enabling Enterprise, Aston University reading)
- Precision teaching training for learning support staff
- Precision teaching resources
- English curriculum training for learning support staff
- Additional early reading phonics based scheme for Key Stage 1.

- 12 week booster intervention programme working with identified, targeted children in Y3 and Y5 (3 days each week)
- Translation service to enable children to have better access to the curriculum. (Dutch/Chinese/Polish and Eritrean)
- Speech Therapist ½ day a week to support targeted children
- Training for learning support staff to provide follow-up work in class
- School Nurse ½ day a week to work with targeted families

### **Impact of Pupil Premium Spending 2014-2015**

Y6, 100% achieved level 4 in reading, 83% level 5.

100% achieved level 4 in writing, 56% level 5.

100% achieved level 4 4 in maths, 28% level 5 and 6% level 6.

Y6 100% made 2 levels progress in reading, writing and maths.

Over 50% of the children who received additional support exceeded expected levels, achieving 3 or 4 levels progress in reading, writing and maths. The Y6 results in Reading, writing and maths are higher than both the local authority and national levels again.

In Y1, 83% of the children passed the phonics screening test which is again above the local authority and national levels.

In Y2, 84% achieved Level 2b+ in reading, 37% Level 3.

In Y2, 74% achieved Level 2b+ in writing, 26% Level 3.

In Y2, 74% achieved Level 2b+ in maths, 32% Level 3.

Progress for the pupil premium children from the end of EYFS to Y2 is 100% in all subjects with 80% accelerated.
