

Impact of Sports Premium 2013-2014

We are continuing to buy into Sports Plus who provide a coach to team teach with the staff. During the year they have covered all the PE modules and this year that support is continuing to enable the staff to deliver outstanding PE provision for the children.

All lesson plans have been provided as have assessments following the completion of each module.

The impact of this has been that all members of staff now feel much more confident in delivering the different modules of the PE curriculum. It has empowered them to raise the standards of PE provision across the school. It also means that planning for each module is now in place for subsequent years.

The coach, who is in school three afternoons a week, also supports with Zumba at lunch time as well as the Sports coaches who come in each day to work with the children at lunch times. She also runs a Zumba after school club for KS1. The impact is that the pupils are able to participate in further PE activities including competitive team games.

We have joined with the King Edward's Sports Partnership which includes various training courses open to staff (where applicable). It also includes regular meetings between PE Coordinators, possible coaching opportunities in school for areas of teaching that need to be strengthened and access to various sports competitions for a range of age groups. Through the KESP we have gained access to the Youth Sports Trust, paying a discounted fee of £130 rather than £300. The impact of this has been access to a wider range of resources and sporting activities including those linked to the new curriculum. The PE Coordinator has also had the opportunity to develop his skills, knowledge and understanding of the issues surrounding the implementation of the new PE curriculum.

Various items of PE equipment have been replaced, mainly due to wear and tear. Completely new items of equipment have been purchased in order to enhance the provision of PE in school. These include: netballs, hockey sticks, basketballs, bibs/team bands, a parachute and goal posts.
