
## St Joseph's Parish

## Y6 Secondary Transfer Applications for September 2024

**All children in Year 6** must now apply for a secondary school place for September 2024. Online application is now open on the Birmingham City Council website at <a href="https://eadmissions.birmingham.gov.uk/prefs.php">https://eadmissions.birmingham.gov.uk/prefs.php</a>

Secondary Transfer preferences for school places must be submitted to the City council by **Tuesday 31**<sup>st</sup> **October 2023.** Please ensure that you have applied for places by then, as late applications are less likely to get the school of their choice.

It has come to our attention from the admissions department that over half of our Y6 children have still not applied for their secondary place! If you require help in doing so, please come into school and ask for an appointment.

## Starting School - Reception 2024

If you have a child that was born between 01-09-2019 and 31-08-2020, online application is now open on the Birmingham City Council website for Reception school places for September 2024. Preferences for school places must be submitted to the city council by 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024. Please ensure that you have applied for places by then, as late applications are less likely to get the school of their choice
