Backpacks

Starting School - Reception 2024

If you have a child that was born between 01-09-2019 and 31-08-2020, online application opens on Sunday 1st October on the Birmingham City Council website for Reception school places for September 2024. Please note that paper applications are no longer available and applications must be submitted via the website. Preferences for school places must be submitted to the city council by 15th January 2024. Please ensure that you have applied for places by then, as late applications are less likely to get the school of their choice
