H1	Uses timelines to place events in order.
H2	Understands a timeline can be divided into BC and AD.
H3	Uses words and phrases: century, decade.
H6	Uses evidence to describe past: houses and settlements, culture and leisure activities, clothes, way of life and actions of people, buildings and their use, belief's and attitudes, things of importance to people, differences between rich and poor.
H6	Uses evidence to find out how any of these may have changed during a time period. Describes similarities and differences between people, events and objects
H9	Shows changes on a timeline
H13	Look at 2 versions of same event and identify differences in the accounts.
H16	Uses printed sources, the internet, pictures, photos, music, artefacts, historic buildings and visits to collect information about the past.
H17	Asks questions such as 'how did people ....? What did people do for ....?'
H19	Suggests sources of evidence to use to help answer questions.
H20	Presents findings about past using speaking, writing, ICT and drawing skills
H21	Uses dates and terms with increasing accuracy.
H23	Discusses different ways of presenting information for different purposes.
