## Maths –

### Decimals and Percentages:

- Assess what they have created.

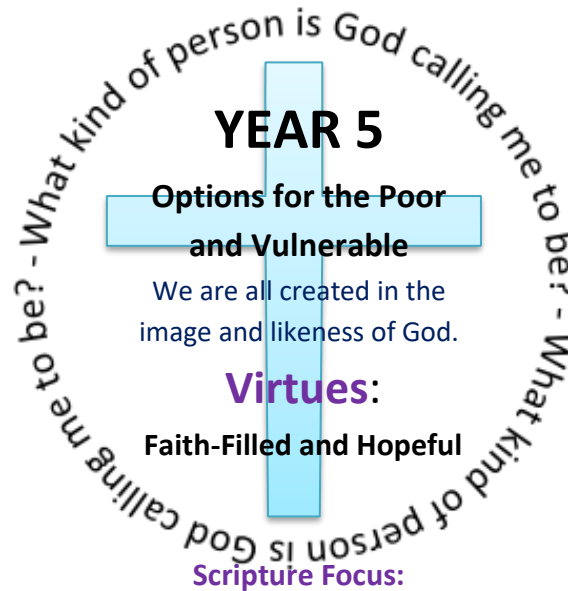
## P.E. – Swimming
