Decimals:

Negative numbers:

Understanding neg. numbers / counting through zero / difference.

Converting Units:

kg, km, mm, ml / converting units of length / converting metric and imperial units / calculate with timetables / units of time.

Volume:

Cubic cm / comparing volume / estimating volume and capacity.
