### YOU HAVE OPTIONS

If you are in need and are experiencing hardship and poverty, food banks are located city wide and provide emergency provisions such as food and toiletries for approximately 3 days. Food banks can also provide some additional support such as debt advice, grant applications, signposting, mental health support and benefits guidance.



Trussell Trust is a helpline who can provide a food bank voucher code over the phone - <u>0808 208 2138</u> Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm. Closed on public holidays.

Alternatively, you can access a Pantry, for a small weekly subscription, you will have access to food that you choose, including fresh fruit and vegetables, meat and store cupboard favourites, which will often be worth around £15-£20



- <u>Household Support Fund</u> Apply for a grant of up to £200 to help with food or energy bills. Search "Household Support Fund" on the Council's website for details.
- <u>Warm Welcome Spaces</u> Local venues offering free hot drinks, warmth, and company. Search "Warm Welcome Spaces Birmingham" online via the council website.











### <u>Support at the Nishkam Centre –</u> <u>Community Safety Net</u>

Located in Handsworth, the **Nishkam Centre** is a values-led, Sikh faith-inspired community hub that offers a wide range of support services to local residents. One of its key services is the **Community Safety Net (CSN)** — a free and confidential advice service supporting people with a variety of challenges.

The CSN offers help across several important areas:

### Welfare and Benefits

Support with Universal Credit, PIP, Attendance Allowance, backdated claims, and appeals. The team can also help if your benefits have been suspended or refused.

### **Housing Support**

Advice on applying for council housing, help with rent arrears, emergency repairs, and accessing essential utilities like water and energy.

### **Debt Advice**

Get help managing your finances, dealing with creditors, and setting up payment plans or disputing debts.


This culturally sensitive service is open to all and operates mainly by phone, with face-to-face appointments available for those who need extra support. In 2024–25 alone, the service helped hundreds of local residents and achieved millions in successful outcomes for those in need.

### Need support?







### Family Support

Sametimes children and their families might need some extra help, this might come from a range of different organisations, all working together.

Our Family Support Practitioners support local families via self referral or professional referral. This can either be from contacting the nearest Family Hub or via the Birmingham Foreard Shape Website.

An Early Help Assessment is corried out between the Family and Family Support Practitioners, which is a way of recording down what is going well in your family, what are the worries and what needs to happen to help things improve

You might need help in one or more of the following prece:

- School, Education or Training
- Home and Life Relationships Health and Emotional Wellbeing
- Work, Finances or Housing
- Domestic Violence or Abu Crime or Anti-Social behaviour

### Community Support

Our Family and Community Liaison Navigators, help to establish links between Family Hubs and Health, Education, Faith, Community and Voluntary Sectors.

Community Support, help grow the local network of partners, to support how services can be delivered in different venues in each District. where you, our families tell us they are needed most, through Family Voices and Parent Consultations.

The team also supports with tackling poverty in the city by supporting families with Grants, Warm. Clather for Children, Safer Sleep schemes and supporting Fornilles in Temporary Accommodation.

The team also lead on running events with our colleagues from SEND, Early Years and Family Support throughout the year from Eld, Christmas Parties to celebrating international Women's Day. They also support other local organisations with family events, such as Schools, Partner Organisations and Community Group.

### **Early Years Support.**

Our Early Years Practitioners deliver weekly Play and Learn sessions that take place at each centre, these are free to attend, no booking required for children aged 0-5 years.



Our Play and Learns sessions help di your child with supporting School-Readiness Parenting Skills and any Early Intervention.

The Play and Learns sessions encourage both Indoor and Outdoor play, with Social Interaction with peers.

Our Sarty Years Practitioners also support with 2 years development screening.

### **SEND Support**

Groups across the district which is a specific Play and Learn groups for children aged 0-5, who are diagnosed and undiagnosed with additional needs. These are referral only groups ensuring small group numbers for those who are attending

The SEND team also deliver a beepoke "Faatsteps" programme which affers support to the parents of children with SEND and offer them on-going support when their children begin runnery and school



### **Early Help Support**

Early Help is a support service for children and young people aged 0–19 (or up to 25 if they have Special Educational Needs and Disabilities – SEND), as well as their families.

We're here to offer early support with a wide range of issues, including:

- Money and budgeting advice
- Housing and accommodation support
  - Bereavement and loss
  - Mental health and wellbeing
    - SEND guidance

...and many other areas where a helping hand might be needed.

Our focus is on stepping in early—before things get more serious—to help you manage challenges and avoid the need for more specialist services later on.
